



### **Te Ture Kura/School of Law PhD Scholarship**

The School of Law is delighted to offer one PhD scholarship in 2020 to cover the student fees of the successful applicant. The scholarship is available for study in any field of law or legal studies (subject to the availability of supervision).

Interested students should send their application to [law-enquiries@canterbury.ac.nz](mailto:law-enquiries@canterbury.ac.nz) with the subject line '**University of Canterbury School of Law doctoral scholarship**', supplying a CV, a copy of their academic record, and a brief research proposal (around 1,500 words).

The scholarship will be awarded by a selection committee comprising the Dean of the School of Law, the Director of Postgraduate Studies of the School of Law, and the Head of the School of Law.

Criteria for the award will include: the quality of the proposal, the availability of a supervisory team at the School of Law for the given project, and adequate Grade Point Average (GPA).

#### **Further Details**

1. Each scholarship will cover the tuition fees for PhD study for the duration of the scholarship (up to a maximum of three years).
2. Scholarships will be used to cover tuition fees only and will be subject to students satisfying the University of Canterbury's satisfactory progress requirements for PhD students.
3. Continuation of the award each year is conditional upon the scholar maintaining satisfactory academic progress in the PhD.
4. PhD students are also entitled to apply to the School of Law Research Fund for appropriate research expenditure (such as presentation of research at appropriate conferences).
5. The scholarship may be held with any other scholarship, prize, or award, unless the conditions of the other awards preclude it.
6. Prospective applicants are encouraged to contact prospective supervisors in advance of any application. Details of staff research interests and contact details can be found via the UC Law website: <https://www.canterbury.ac.nz/law/people/>
